2	 Councillor Darouze Councillor Darouze introduced himself After the Oct 24th election, Vars will be part of the Osgood Ward, along with Carlsbad Springs and Bearbrook. Councillor Darouze currently represents the Osgoode Ward and he is seeking re-election. His office is located at 8243 Victoria Street in Metcalfe and every Tuesday from 1pm to 5pm. He is in the office for "walk in visits" from members of the community. His assistant: Jane Diraimo is the "liaison" between the various community associations in the Osgoode Ward and George Darouze.

5	Remembrance Day Preparations for the Vars Remembrance Day Ceremony at the Cenotaph are well under way. The ceremony will be held at the Cenotaph on November 6th at 2pm, followed by exhibits and refreshments in the St Guillaume gym afterwards.	
6	 Skating Rink Plans were made and discussed for the rink maintenance for the 2022-2023 season. The VCA is still in the quoting stage for the "outdoor rink plus plan": a fully accessible multi-use pad that will be used year-round. The VCA would like to make our rink a permanent structure: ex: a cement floor: this would allow the rink to freeze easier and faster in the winter and will allow the Vars residents to use the rink year round. The rink in the summer could be used as a tennis court, a pickleball court. 	
7	 Septic Tank Leak A Vars resident joined the VCA meeting to discuss a leaking septic tank at 5779 Rockdale Road, Vars. The septic tank is leaking and seeping into the neighbor's yard. The city has been called and it was advised repairs would be done to the septic tank "in the fall". 	
8	 Street Lights A Vars resident asked about the possibility of installing street lights in the newer project in Vars. Councillor Darouze explained that there are no street lights installed in rural housing projects. Street lights are only installed on the "main street" of a village and at intersections. The responsibility of lighting the streets in the project falls on the builder.
